US Patent For Dynamic Identity Matching Responds to Threat Levels

PORT TOWNSEND, WASHINGTON – June 24, 2015 – Intellicheck Mobilisa, Inc. (NYSE MKT:IDN), a leader in real-time identity authentication and verification solutions, today announced it has been awarded a US Patent for dynamic identity matching in response to threat levels. The new patent offers strong protection for the innovative technology underlying the Defense ID[®] and Law ID[™] products relevant to real-time database queries and returning law enforcement-related information. The patent also has significant value for planned future product applications that deal with public safety, security and terrorism.

The patent addresses product technology that identifies persons of interest to determine whether they pose a threat by matching their identities with data returned from computer-based queries made using fixed or mobile devices terminals. The returned data indicates whether the individual is suspected, charged or convicted of crimes or threats that correspond with specific alerts and threat conditions, enhancing the security authority's situational awareness and safety. The technology is customizable and can be configured to rank query returns and display alerts relative to one or more acts for which the person of interest is suspected, charged or convicted. Other product features enable customizable matching of the person in question's identity with a back-end database, which compares the identity with known and suspected criminal acts.

Commenting on the new patent, Intellicheck Mobilisa CEO Dr. William Roof noted, "Our goal is to continually innovate and deliver immediate and pertinent information that provides real-time situational awareness and helps authorities effectively isolate a person of interest based upon dynamic criteria, such as an alert or a threat level, as well as customizable rules-based searches. Our industry-leading products feature breakthrough technologies offering law enforcement authorities the capability to perform dynamic identity matching, which we view as a major advantage in providing enhanced security and protection."

The new patent adds to the Company's significant patent portfolio and enhances Intellicheck's focus on delivering value for customers and investors. "This patent underscores our company's continuing commitment to advancing pioneering identification authentication technology solutions. It highlights our foresight and leadership in delivering value-driven, innovative products," said Dr. Roof.
